
The designer Alexander Girard was one of the leading figures in American design during the postwar era. In 1967, he presented the Splayed Leg Table as part of his furniture collection 'The Girard Group'.

The new re-edition of the Splayed Leg Table by Vitra revives the side table with its characteristic four-legged base. The tapered legs in die-cast aluminium seem to grow out of the table top as a bundled cluster before elegantly spreading

outward and culminating in the pronounced round feet. The square marble table tops are available in white or black and underscore the timeless, understated character of the Splayed Leg Table, whose compact dimensions make it a perfect fit in all manner of interior settings.

- **Table top:** Carrara marble (white, matte finish) or Marquina marble (black, glossy finish), top thickness 15 mm.
- **Base:** polished die-cast aluminium.
- **Glides:** plastic glides (non-adjustable).


