Taking its design cues from stools used by cobblers, the ML42 profiles a light and elegant look. Designed by Mogens Lassen in 1942 and since updated to modern needs, the three-legged design is shaped in wood for a natural, lasting expression.

Set on tripod-like legs, with a metal footrest on bar and counter versions for comfort when seated for prolonged periods, it is at once sturdy and sculptural, with a small footprint that makes it ideal for use in a range of settings. A natural extension of the body, the seat is moulded to comfortably accommodate any figure. While lightweight and easy to move around, it offers a high level of comfort. Offered in three different heights, the ML42 is available in black-stained beech, soap-treated oak and brown-oiled oak and with a stainless steel, brass or copper footrest.

About the designer

Considered one of Denmark's greatest and most influential architects, Mogens Lassen (1901–1987) pioneered Danish Functionalism, taking his cues from Bauhaus sensibilities. His interior designs are a natural continuation of his architectural approach and add energy and atmosphere to everyday living spaces and tasks. From decorative objects to larger furniture designs, each delicately balances presence with practicality, and without drawing undue attention to find its natural place in any space.


